[V] 次の英文を読み、設問 1～11 に答えなさい。

The ancient Egyptians seemed to center their lives about death. It was important for a dead body to remain as nearly intact as possible in order that (A)it might enter the afterlife. To keep the body safe, it was enclosed in a well-made tomb. This was particularly important in the case of the Pharaoh, for he represented the entire nation, and (B) his welfare the welfare of all Egypt depended. With the Pharaoh, a great deal of treasure was buried (presumably for his use in the afterworld), which meant there would be grave robbers (C) off. (D), the tombs were made elaborate indeed. By 2600 B.C., (E)they took the form of immense structures starting from a square base and tapering up to a point. The largest structure of this sort was completed about 2580 B.C. by Pharaoh Khufu. [1. have 2. is 3. it 4. supposed 5. taken 6. to] twenty years to build, with (F)a hundred thousand men laboring at it. It is built of (G)two million three hundred thousand slabs of granite with an average weight of 2.5 tons each, and the whole was built by the unaided muscles of human beings. The square base covers an area of thirteen acres (755 feet on each side) and the (H)high is 481 feet.

The Greek tourists were very surprised at the structures, as, indeed, we ourselves are today. They called them “pyramides,” the singular being “pyramis.” This word may be a distortion of the Egyptian word “pi-mar” for the structure, with a bit of influence from the Greek word “pyr” meaning “fire” because the structures reached high up like frozen flames.
