The interior of Kumamoto Castle's main tower reopened to the public June 28 following the completion of repairs from the 2016 earthquakes in the region that knocked off roof tiles and collapsed walls. The twin quakes damaged many buildings inside the castle area. The castle tower was initially supposed to reopen in April but was delayed due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The Kumamoto city government aimed to fix the castle tower as a symbol of recovery as early as possible and completed the repairs at the end of March.

All living cells contain protein. This would suggest that protein is a substance necessary to life. And, in fact, we get our word "protein" from a Greek word meaning "(A)," because proteins are thought to be the most important part of living matter.

Each kind of cell has its own protein. The proteins are made up of combinations of substances called "amino acids." (\checkmark) Each amino acid group contains the chemical element nitrogen, (B) addition to carbon, hydrogen, and oxygen. The different amino acids can combine in different ways to form different proteins, and [1. are 2. different 3. of 4. there 5. thousands] proteins.

Many of the foods that are considered important (C) us to eat are so because of the proteins they contain. These include milk, eggs, lean meats, fish, peas, beans, peanuts, and certain grains. They are important to man because they provide him with the amino acids that his body cannot make for itself. (\square) In fact, they are called the "essential amino acids," which means the body cannot get along (D) them.

Man cannot store amino acids in his body for (E) use. (\land) Bread and milk have to be eaten at the same meal, so the amino acids they provide can be used together to form new body tissue.

Moderate amounts of different kinds of protein foods should be eaten at each meal. ($\,=\,$)
