Starbucks is reducing the price of food items nearing best-before dates by 20 percent if they remain unsold three hours before closing time. The outlets will decide whether to cut the price depending on the amount of unsold items each day and may not always offer discounts, the company said.

Primitive people practiced a kind of medicine that we would call magic. (/) Or, (A) accident, they may have discovered that the warmth of a fire (B) a sprained shoulder, or an herb drink helped a stomach-ache. Many primitive peoples of today can set and splint a broken bone, or use plants that are laxatives or that [1. people 2. put 3. sleep 4. to 5. will].

But doctors as such seem to have existed from the earliest civilizations. The Babylonians left medical writings describing various diseases so clearly that doctors today can recognize (1)them. The ancient Egyptians had medical treatments, and these included pills and ointments containing drugs. (\Box)

A man called Aesculapius was the earliest physician in Greek history. He practiced a kind of magic medicine. But gradually true medicine began to develop. A man called Hippocrates, who lived about 400 B.C., did so much to rescue medicine (C) such magic and superstition that he is called the "Father of Medicine."

In his writings he taught that the physician should observe the patient closely and accurately. He should use gentle treatment and try to encourage the natural healing process.

(^) He should keep the patient's secrets.

Hippocrates also recognized and described many diseases. (=) (D) perhaps we can call him the world's first doctor in terms of what we mean by (2)that today.
